CLASSING MOHAIR FOR WEAVING TRIAL BEGINS

Approx 1300 kilograms of weaving type mohair has been sorted for the weaving mohair trial, of the 1300kgs submitted, approximately 777 kilograms was classed into weaving lines. Mohair which did not make the grade for weaving types in the vast majority of cases was due to this fibre not meeting the

minimum length requirement; It is essential producers check there animals prior to shearing to ensure the minimum 120mm will be achieved when they are shorn.

The first batch of mohair for the project was classed on the 1st and 2nd of June at Ammo in Narrandera by Mr GT Ferreira and AMMO classing staff Jim Stanley and Craig Clancy.

Since the classing of this first consignment was undertaken we have received a further 850-900 kilograms of fibre, once spring shearing commences we should be well under way to achieving the target quantity required.

The **closing date** for the weaving type mohair, to be into our Narrandera Store is the **11th of October**, mohair received after that date will be classed at a later date.

QLD Transport


Queensland producers will know by now that they can no longer use QLink or the rail to transport bales.

An alternate arrangement has been made through G&D Partners, 67 Boundary Rd Carol Park, for collection by DePaoli Transport.

However please be warned that sending one bale alone will cost \$132, and it is cheaper to pool and send many bales (\$50 per bale)


If you have only a small number of animals to shear, coordinating shearing time with other local mohair producers will help to make it worthwhile for the shearer to travel to your area.



Weaving Type Mohair

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AMMO, in consultation with GT Ferreira, is classing into lines of weaving type mohair. It would be hoped that there would be a sufficient quantity of weaving type hair to make the trial a success. Payment of a premium above the Australian auction price will be paid for the mohair in this trial. To ensure consistency in the mohair type the following procedure has been determined:



PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Growers will be charged for the on farm inspection of animals. This is payable to GT Ferreira.
- 2. Growers will incur a charge for the testing of the fleece samples.
- 3. Normal AMMO charges will apply i.e. handling, classing and commission.
- 4. It is anticipated that payment will be made after classing of the consignment. AMMO will deduct all charges and then forward the net proceeds to the grower.

David Wallace Charles better known as Wal, was, by his own admission, coerced into the mohair industry by his wife, when she purchased three animals as the start of a small flock on their Grong Grong property near Narrandera. Pretty soon he became enthusiastic about the potential of these new animals and became embroiled in the move to establish a grower controlled marketing system for the fibre. He presented a paper to the Annual General Meeting of the Angora Breed Society (A.B.S) of Australia in Melbourne on the 12th November 1976 discussing ways that the industry could better improve the marketing of Australian Mohair, and together with others in the Riverina Region set up a grower controlled body to give producers representation in the marketing of their fibre.

After the success of the first sale, Wal set about trying to locate a suitable property that could be used to house this new venture. After renting a few different sheds, and with the business continuing to grow, Wal helped in the formalisation of the company in 1983 and with its establishment of premises in its current location in 1988. Wal's dream was always to better utilise our site right beside the railway line, but sadly with the decline of rail services this has not come to fruition. Wall served as a volunteer staff member and

A Director of the company until 2003 and maintained an active interest and often attended sales and AGM's thereafter. During his time in the industry he has seen prices go from \$2/kg to \$60/kg and back to the levels they are today. Wal remained enthusiastic for the fibre and its qualities and would always be ready to promote the industry amongst his peers and friends and in the media.

Wal will best be remembered locally for his "old grey bus" an antiquated Valiant that he drove right up to his hospitalisation, but in the industry he will be remembered for his vision, drive and forethought, and his willingness to talk mohair to one and all. Our thoughts are with his family and partner, Joan at this sad time.
