MOHAIR WEEKEND

The Australian Mohair industry took centre stage on our AGM's weekend, with the attendance of Mr Cesare Savio owner of Safil and Mr Gotz Giebel and Mr Ivan Smith.

Safil is one of the most highly regarded Yarn spinners throughout the world and with their support plus the help of GT Ferreira, our producers ,MAL and AMMO feel very privilege to have a association with such a company.

Our weekend commenced on Friday with the inspection of bales in our river street store, bales were inspected by all buyers except for New England who inspected on Thursday, they were joined by many growers who attended, plus with the attendance of media such as ABC Radio, Landline, The Land, Narrandera Argus and Win News over the day gave great coverage to our Industry and witnessed what was a very successful Auction.

Media conducted several interviews with Mr. Savio and Mr Smith, producers and directors from both MAL and AMMO.

Our guests then travelled to Monteagle and Boorowa to look over angora farming, before flying back to Narrandera for Dinner.

On Saturday in what was a First for our Industry AMMO and MAL conducted their AGM's one after the other, which I believe also was a success and should be regular fixture in the future.

A discussion was held after the AGMs on the future of the Aust. mohair industry, talking on the direction the mohair industry may take in future was held, producers who attended asked many questions and suggested several ideas which could aid the development of the industry.

Saturday evening was very informative and well received by all in attendance notable points of the evening included a video detailing the Safil groups operation and speech by Mr Savio.

Other speakers included Mr Ivan Smith and GT Ferreira.

MARKET REPORT

Australian Record's Fell again in the last Auction of 2014, which was held in Narrandera on the 28th of November.

On offer was 34,928 kgs in 186 bales, 58 lots. 100% Clearance

Once again on the back of very strong demand Australian prices saw Records broken, a 29.8 micron Young Goat line selling at 3090 c/kg surpassing the previous mark of 2820 c/kg with New England wool being the buyer. Mohair Wool Traders purchased a lot of Fine Fine Adult BFFH 32.5 micron at 1845 c/kg an Australian record .

The top price on the day was 4650 c/kg for a lot of 24.7 micron BFFKID, bought by New England Wool.

The overall average of the Auction rose from 1770 c/kg in August to 1913 c/kg.

REPORT ON WEAVING TYPE

It was encouraging to see the commitment and general improvement in the quality of fibre received for the latest classing of weaving type mohair.

The turnaround in preparation & quality of mohair from growers showed their extra determination and commitment was truly justified.

Overall the style of the majority of fibre received for this intake was good to very good, considering it was produced from a winter shearing.

It is of the utmost importance for all producers to continue to strive for the best possible results.

It is also of paramount importance that producers strive to produce fibre with the necessary characteristics to ensure it is eligible for the weaving market.

Fibre destined for the weaving market must meet the following criteria, they are as follows;

Good staple length 125mm to 150mm, Fibre must have good Tensile Strength, Freedom of Medulation, Certain Fineness, Uniformity of Length, Good Lustre, Healthy Growth and Good Clean Yield.

Producers also need to be aware of potential contamination risks such as the number 1 offender Baling Twine and Foreign Fibres from other farm animal breeds and domesticated pets.
